Abstract

Around two thirds of the staff of IOs in the United Nations system work in the field where they implement IO policy or liaise with member states. While there is variation between organizations, there is a group of distinctive “operative international organizations” with responsibilities in the areas of development, humanitarian aid, environment, health and peacekeeping. This Panel brings together Papers with a comparative perspective on IOs in policy implementation or at the field level who look beyond the idiosyncrasies of individual organizations or policy fields to understand the challenges of operational international organizations.
